

T/5 CONCENTRATE

- Leaf Shine
 Foliage Cleaner
 - ■Floral Green Extender

For use on Hard Leaf Tropical Foliage Plants and Cut Floral Greens

NET 1 GALLON/3.78 LITERS

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Read entire label before use. These dilution rates are just a suggestion, personal preference may vary ratios.

FOR HARD LEAF TROPICAL FOLIAGE PLANTS

PLANTS SHOULD BE WATERED PRIOR TO APPLICATION. PLANTS SHOULD NOT BE TREATED IN DIRECT SUNLIGHT. ALWAYS SPOT TEST PLANTS FIRST FOR SENSITIVITY TO SPRAYS.

CLEANING: (1:20 ratio) To make 1 gallon of Foliage Cleaner add 3/4 cup T/5 Concentrate to 15 1/4 cups of cold water in a clean container. Shake and pour mixture into clean sprayer. Shake frequently during use. Completely spray top surface of leaves until mixture runs off and let dry. For heavily soiled leaves rinse off with clean water or wipe off with a clean soft cloth dampened with diluted *Pixie*.

SHINING: (1:12 ratio) To make 1 gallon of Leaf Shine add 1 1/4 cups T/5 Concentrate to 14 3/4 cups of cold water in a clean container. Shake and pour mixture into clean sprayer. Shake frequently during use. Completely spray top surface of leaves and let dry or wipe off with a clean soft cloth dampened with diluted *Pixie*.

FOR CUT FLORAL GREENS

GREENS SHOULD NOT BE TREATED IN DIRECT SUNLIGHT. ALWAYS SPOT TEST GREENS FIRST FOR SENSITIVITY TO SPRAYS.

You may Clean and Shine Cut Floral Greens the same way suggested above for Plants.

TO EXTEND THE USEFUL LIFE OF CUT FLORAL GREENS

GREENS SHOULD NOT BE TREATED IN DIRECT SUNLIGHT. ALWAYS SPOT TEST GREENS FIRST FOR SENSITIVITY TO DIPPING.

DIPPING: (1:32 ratio) To make 1 gallon of Floral Green Extender add 1/2 cup T/5 Concentrate to 15 1/2 cups of cold water in a clean container. Stir frequently during use. Dip full bunches of greens into solution, shake off excess solution, and repack loosely in box. Extra solution should be stored in cooler to retard bacterial multiplication. Due to the bacteria present in all water, solution should be changed every few days and the container cleaned before refilling.

PRECAUTIONARY INFORMATION

Overspray or Splashing can create slippery floors. Proper covering should be used to avoid overspray or splashing on any surface that may spot or stain.

CAUTION! Avoid contact with eyes. Wash hands thoroughly after use or before eating, smoking or drinking. When spraying, use in well ventilated area.

FIRST-AID: In case of eye contact, immediately flush eyes with plenty of water. If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting. Get medical attention if irritation develops or persists or if any other adverse side effect occurs.
